However, once we experience the thrill of total surrender and dependence on the Holy Spirit as He uses us in these crusades, it converts the hearer of the Word and it transforms us in ways that eyes have not seen or ears ever heard!

It's gonna be good y'all. He promised that if He is lifted up, HE WILL draw all men to Himself. Can't wait to lift Jesus up alongside you real soon.

#### **Testimony of Siv Ashley**



My narrative unfurls in the tapestry of 1971, amidst the humble abode of a destitute Cambodian family. Despite our economic hardships, love enveloped us, courtesy of devoted family members. Around the age of eight, my father embarked on a journey to the capital to trade goods and secure funds for my brother's and my education. Little did he know that this expedition would introduce him to the resplendent name of Jesus, altering the trajectory of our lives. Infused with newfound beliefs, my father returned home, radiating joy as he shared the gospel. In unity, our family embraced this newfound faith.

However, the fateful day of April 16, 1975, transformed my life irrevocably. The echoes of bombs, gunfire, and sirens disrupted our innocent play, thrusting my brother and me into a nightmarish work camp. Days unfolded in toil, devoid of sustenance, punctuated by brutal beatings. Starvation claimed the lives of some, and with each visit to my family, I confronted a harrowing tableau – a gradual disintegration of their physical and mental well-being.

Yet, amidst this descent into darkness, I clung to the beacon of faith my father had illuminated. His resolute voice echoed, "Believe, and you will go to a place called America," accompanied by the comforting verses of John 3:16, etched in his memory.

The narrative twists into a heart-wrenching escape attempt, my father's demise, and the brutal revelation of my brother's passing in a desolate camp. As I navigated the despondent landscape, the resolute cry of Psalm 71 resonated within me – a plea for deliverance from the clutches of cruelty. However, providence intervened, leading me through a perilous escape and into the arms of an unknown savior. The path through the forest mirrored the agony of loss, yet I clung to Proverbs 3:5, trusting in the Lord's guidance.

My odyssey continued, weaving through the terror of grenades, the solace of a refugee camp in Thailand, and ultimately, the embrace of Jefferson United Methodist Church in North Carolina. Here, amidst the folds of red, white, and blue, the Gospel was preached, and the love of Jesus permeated my heart. Psalm 34:18 became a balm for my broken spirit.

Today, after 32 years of marriage, with two cherished children and a daughter-in-law, I traverse the globe, sharing the message of Jesus. Hebrews 11:1 encapsulates the essence of my father's teachings – faith as confidence in the unseen.

In gratitude, I acknowledge God's role in my life, where blessings outweigh the pain. This is the testimony of a life shaped by adversity but sustained by an enduring faith in Christ. Each day, I express thanks for this remarkable journey, and through recounting my brief life story, I extend my deepest appreciation to you for allowing me to share it.



## What's Your Story?

Did you know that you have a story to tell? Too often I have heard many people say, "I don't have a story" or "No one wants to hear my story." I have even heard people ask, "How would my story make a difference?"

Whether you grew up in church, became a new believer as a young adult, or have just recently received Jasus as your personal Savior, "YOU HAVE A STORY!"

Likely in everyone's life, there was a time when God was not there or seemed far away, and then over time or all in one moment, God inserted Himself into your life and gave you a story to tell.
