----- EVANGELISM -----

We will be joining with the International Commission based out of Lewisville, Texas for our evangelism phase; this evangelism effort is known as Project Andrew.

The International Commission has been touching lives around the world for fifty years. This ministry is devoted to equipping and enabling believers to reach unbelievers and make disciples. This is not a “door-to-door” campaign, it's a refreshing strategy for our churches to

We have hosted several informational meetings with Pastors who have chosen to participate in this church-based evangelism project during April 19-25 of this year. ----- PRAYER -----

The second major emphasis for the new year will be Prayer. Our Great Commission Prayer Team has been very active for months. We have designed a workshop for our Pastors on March 16th.
