Little brown bags, and small white envelopes were tools in my pastor's hands.

As I look back on the formative years of my life I can easily recall the names of men and women who had an impact on my life. Names such as our first grade teacher, "junior high-school" principal, and our football coach are on the tip of my tongue as I think back on the days where things were simpler.

The person whose name brings back the fondest of memories is that of my Pastor. This man set a high standard for everybody who lived in the small farming town where I grew up. When the volunteer fire department's siren sounded, he was almost always the first man on the way to the location of the fire. He made countless hospital visits. Preached dozens, if not hundreds of weddings and funerals. At each and every sporting event he was there cheering on our home team, then at half time he could be found scooping popcorn into the little brown paper bags at the 4-H Club's snack bar. He was the example of Pastor to our entire community. I know of several funerals where he would make himself available to citizens whose pastors had moved away. He would step in and perform funerals for virtually anybody, always without thought of receiving any financial appreciation.

When our third grade Teacher's family lost their house to a grass fire, he was on scene to help fight the fire, pray with the family, and organize a "city wide" benefit to raise money for the family of seven. I witnessed him shed tears when young children walked the aisle of our little church to make their "public profession of faith". He would be the first person at church on Sunday and the last one to put his key in the door following church.

I have seen him take his church check to the bank so that he could cash it and put money into a small white envelope for a family in need. Often he would leave the bank and personally take that unmarked white envelope to the location where he knew the mom or dad would be laboring to make ends meet. As he would hand that envelope over, a slight grin would appear on his face and these words would come out of his mouth: "This small token from our church is given in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord to you and your family." I was young, but I am confident that the money that he pulled out of the bank was from his personal account and not that of the church. He was always confident, faithful, and dedicated to our Lord. A fine servant of God.

As I look back on those memories, I pause to thank God for the men who have been in my life, performing the duties of Pastor. They have all made an impact on me, as well as the church in which they served. Along with that, they touched the lives of countless boys and girls, and men and women of our community who so desperately needed a pastor to love on them during their greatest time of need.

Today, I get to serve with many men who are just like the pastor in my story. They have been called to do a work that is very, very special in the heart of God. So, please pray for your pastor. Prepare to honor him next month during "Pastor Appreciation Month"; and remember to give him your encouragement, support, and most importantly your prayers. Not only does he need that, he deserves it as well.

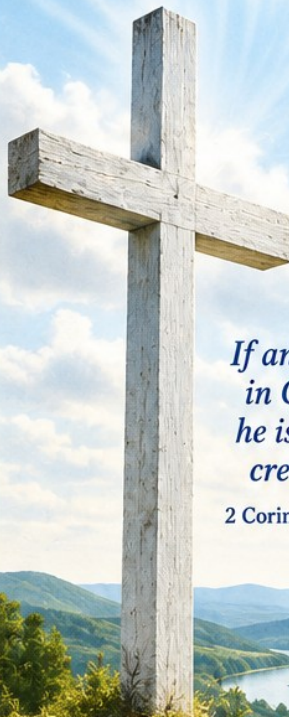
